

TRIP POLICIES

1. Reservations are on first come, first-serve basis. To assure space on a trip, **payment is to be made at the time of registration.**
2. A ten (10) person registration minimum is required for all trips. The trip can possibly be cancelled if the minimum is not met. All participants will be notified at least two days in advance and refunded in full.
3. Any cancellation **must** occur **prior to the registration deadline** to qualify for a refund. **Also if registration deadline has passed and tickets have been purchased, no refund will be given.**
4. Participants will be charged a \$5.00 processing fee if a refund for a trip is requested.
5. Participants traveling with a wheelchair or any other disability that might require special attention; **must notify staff at time of registration.**
6. Drivers will not wait for late comers. Missed paid trips will be considered a donation to the center.
7. All participants will be expected to sign a Hold Harmless agreement per trip, prior to boarding the shuttle bus.
8. All participants will be expected to review, sign, and follow the Trips and Tours Code of Conduct.


En route to the Suquamish Clearwater Resort and Casino, we'll enjoy a ferry ride, stops in Kingston and the opportunity for wine or beer tasting.
