OBJECTIVE OF EXPLORING

THE EXPLORER PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO PROMOTE RESPONSIBILITY, LEADERSHIP, AND ORCHESTRATE AN UNDERSTANDING AND TRAINING OF LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES.

A MAJOR GOAL OF EXPLORING IS TO TEACH YOUNG ADULTS THE MISSIONS, PURPOSES, AND OBJECTIVES OF LAW ENFORCEMENT. MANY EXPLORERS MOVE ONTO CAREERS IN POLICE WORK ON MUNICIPAL, COUNTY, AND STATE LEVELS.

TRAINING

EXPLORERS TRAIN IN MANY DIFFERENT AREAS. LEADERSHIP, SOCIAL NETWORKING, COMMUNITY RELATIONS, LAW ENFORCEMENT DUTIES, CAR ACCIDENT PROCEDURES, PROPER EQUIPMENT OPERATION AND HANDLING, FIREARMS AND MARKSMANSHIP, FIRST AID, EMERGENCY RESPONSE, TACTICAL RESPONSES, ACTIVE SHOOTERS, DUI'S, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, AND THE LIST CONTINUES TO GROW.



EXPLORERS ARE CONFRONTED WITH PUBLIC CONCERNS AND ISSUES ON A REGULAR BASIS FROM EVERYDAY EXPLORER DUTIES. WE FOCUS PART OF OUR EFFORTS ON THE IDEOLOGY OF COMMUNITY POLICING AND PUBLIC RELATIONS. WE EMPHASIZE PROFESSIONALISM IN ALL OF OUR ACTIONS AND PROPER PROCEDURAL REACTIONS. WE ALSO EXPOSE OURSELVES TO NUMEROUS HIGH-STRESS TRAININGS TO IMPLEMENT THE REALITIES OF HARSH POLICE WORK.

EVENTS

EXPLORERS OPERATE IN MANY CITY COMMUNITY EVENTS AS WELL AS THE ENTIRE COUNTY. DUTIES INCLUDE CROWD CONTROL, SECURITY, LOSS PREVENTION, PREDPOL, TRAFFIC CONTROL, HOUSE CHECKS, AND GENERAL COMMUNITY SERVICE. SOME MAJOR EVENTS YOU MAY SEE US ARE THE PUYALLUP FAIR, MEEKER DAYS, BLACK FRIDAY, THE SANTA PARADE, OR WATCH FOR OUR CAR AS WE PATROL.



WLEEA ACADEMY

IN THE SECOND WEEK OF AUGUST, OR THE LAST WEEK OF DECEMBER, THE WLEEA ACADEMY IS HELD IN YAKIMA WHERE EXPLORERS ATTEND A 6 DAY PROGRAM THAT PUSHES THEIR BODIES, TEAMWORK, AND LEADERSHIP TO THE TEST. THEY ARE TAUGHT BY OFFICERS FROM AROUND THE STATE ON DOZENS OF TOPICS. THERE ARE FOUR TYPES OF ACADEMIES FOR EXPLORERS TO ATTEND.
