REGISTRATION

- Registration deadline is September 4th. Registrations after September 4th will be accepted on a space available basis.

FEEES

What are the league fees?

- \$66 (Resident Discount - \$55)

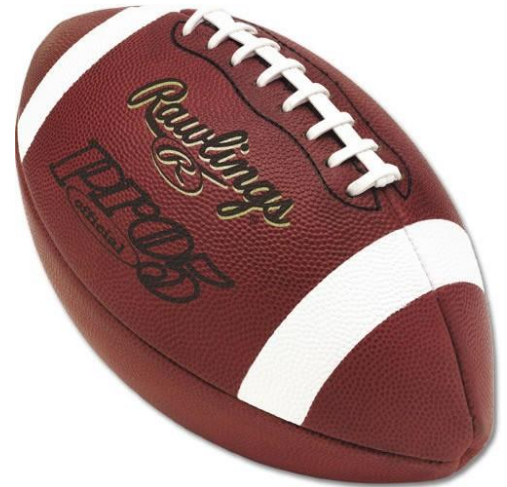
COACHES

Do you still need coaches?

- Yes. We are always looking for volunteer coaches.

How do I become a coach?

- Fill out a coach's application and pass a National Background Check.



ROSTER/PLAYER PLACEMENT

How are rosters put together?

- Teams are formed by a player screening and draft system.

Are siblings placed on the same team?

- Yes if they are registered for the same division.

Can my child play up in the next age division?

- Yes, if they are one grade below the division they want to join (**For Example: if the child is in the 4th grade, they are eligible to play in the NFL Division**).

When will we hear who our coach is and when the first practice is?

- You should hear from your child's coach between September 11th & September 16th. Practices start Saturday, September 18th.

EQUIPMENT/UNIFORM

What equipment do I need to buy for my child?

- None, but we recommend a mouth piece and cleats.

Does Parks & Recreation provide the uniform?

- Yes. We will provide a t-shirt.

What type of ball is used?

- We use a junior size for the NCAA and youth/intermediate size for the NFL.

PRACTICES

When do practices start?

- Practices will start Saturday, September 18th. Each team will practice on a weeknight and Saturday until games start.

What time are practices?

- Weeknight practice will be at 5:30pm or 7:00pm. Saturday practice will range between 9:00am and 5:00pm. Each practice will last one hour and a half. **Practice times are determined by the coaches since they are volunteering their time.**

GAMES

When do games start?

- Games will begin Saturday, October 9th. Each team will play 6 games.

When does the season end?

- The season will end Saturday, November 20th.

How and when do I get the game schedule?

- The game schedule will be emailed to the coach the first week of October and posted on the sports website at www.teamsideline.com/puyallup.

MISC.

When are pictures?

- Pictures will be taken on Saturday, October 16th. Pictures will take place at the Puyallup Recreation Center. Picture packets will be distributed to the coach at the beginning of November.

Does the Puyallup Parks & Recreation supply trophies for the players?
